

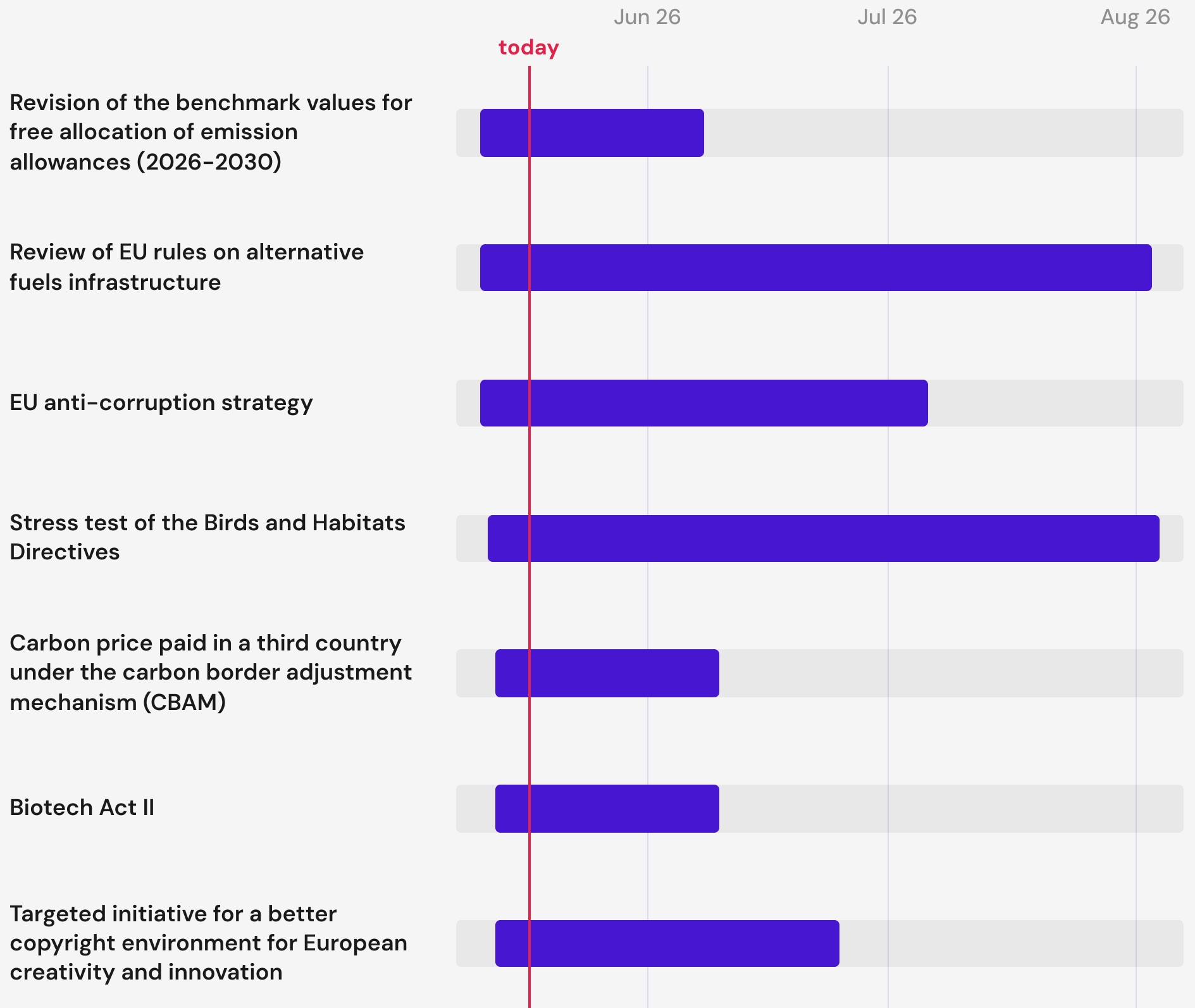

In the context of the 'Fit for 55' package of EU legislation, the ETS Directive has been revised with the EU target set out in the European Climate Law to reduce net greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 55% by 2030, compared to 1990 levels. Following this revision, the European Commission needs to update several regulatory acts for the implementation of the ETS. This initiative updates the benchmarks values for free allocation of emission allowances.

EU rules on alternative fuels infrastructure create a common framework for the deployment of alternative fuels infrastructure in the EU. They must be reviewed by the end of 2026. This review will address among others the appropriateness of the targets for road recharging and refuelling infrastructure as well as the payment and price transparency provisions and a possible extension of the scope of the provisions regarding shore side electricity supply in maritime ports.

Carbon price paid in a third country under the carbon border adjustment mechanism (CBAM)

This initiative will set out rules for the conversion into a corresponding number of CBAM (carbon border adjustment mechanism) certificates of the carbon price effectively paid in a third country for the declared embedded emissions, taking into account any form of compensation available in that country resulting in a reduction of the price.

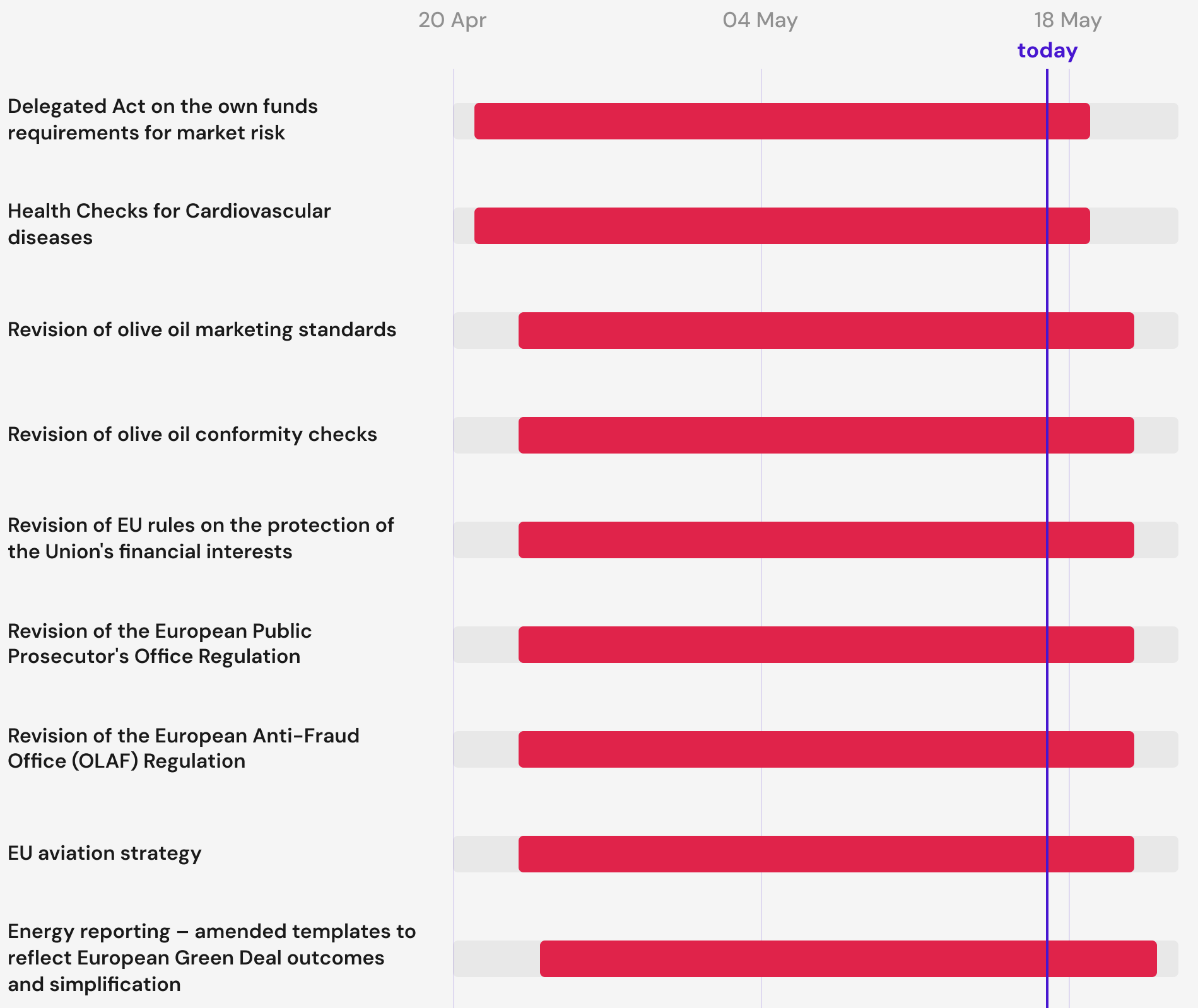

In light of delays and uncertainties in the implementation of the Basel III standards by major jurisdictions, the European Commission considers it necessary, to preserve a level playing field with third countries in terms of own funds requirements, to explore making use of the empowerment of the co-legislators in Regulation (EU) 2024/1623 in relation to the market risk framework.

Health Checks for Cardiovascular diseases

The proposed Council recommendation on health checks for cardiovascular diseases will support Member States in organising evidence-based screening for cardiovascular diseases tailored to their specific health systems and national and regional situations. It aims to improve early detection and diagnosis of cardiovascular diseases and key risk factors, thereby reducing premature mortality from cardiovascular diseases and related non-communicable diseases, while also helping to reduce health inequalities within and between Member States.

The objective of this revision of EU olive oil marketing standards is to bring them in line with the recently adopted changes to the International Olive Council Trade Standard for olive oils and olive pomace oils. It concerns the limit for total sterol content in monovarietal extra virgin olive oil from the Koroneiki or Nocellara del Belice variety and the labelling of such oils.

The objective of this revision of EU olive oil conformity checks is to implement the recently adopted changes to the International Olive Council Trade Standard for olive oils and olive pomace oils. It lays down obligations for operators regarding the traceability of monovarietal extra virgin olive oil from the Koroneiki or Nocellara del Belice variety and obligations for authorities in Member States to check such oils.

Revision of EU rules on the protection of the Union's financial interests

EU rules on the protection of the Union's financial interests aims to prevent fraud and protect the financial interests of the Union. The initiative will assess the impact of national law transposing those rules and may be accompanied, by a legislative proposal to revise them. This will provide the opportunity to align those rules with new legislation such as on anti-corruption, further strengthening the Union's anti-fraud infrastructure.

The European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO) investigates, prosecutes and brings to judgment crimes affecting the financial interests of the Union. Four years into its operations, the Commission will assess the EPPO's performance and challenges. An impact assessment will explore ways to improve efficiency, ensuring that EU funds serve their intended purpose. The EPPO's role in the wider EU anti-fraud architecture will also be considered ahead of a potential revision.

Revision of the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) Regulation

Based on Regulation 883/2013, the EU Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) investigates wrongdoing affecting the EU's financial interests and misconduct within the EU institutions and bodies. Feeding into an ongoing review of the EU antifraud architecture (AFA) launched in July 2025, the Commission is currently evaluating the Regulation; an impact assessment will explore ways to improve its effectiveness and efficiency. A proposal to revise the Regulation may accompany the Commission Communication on the results of the AFA review foreseen for Q4-2026.
