

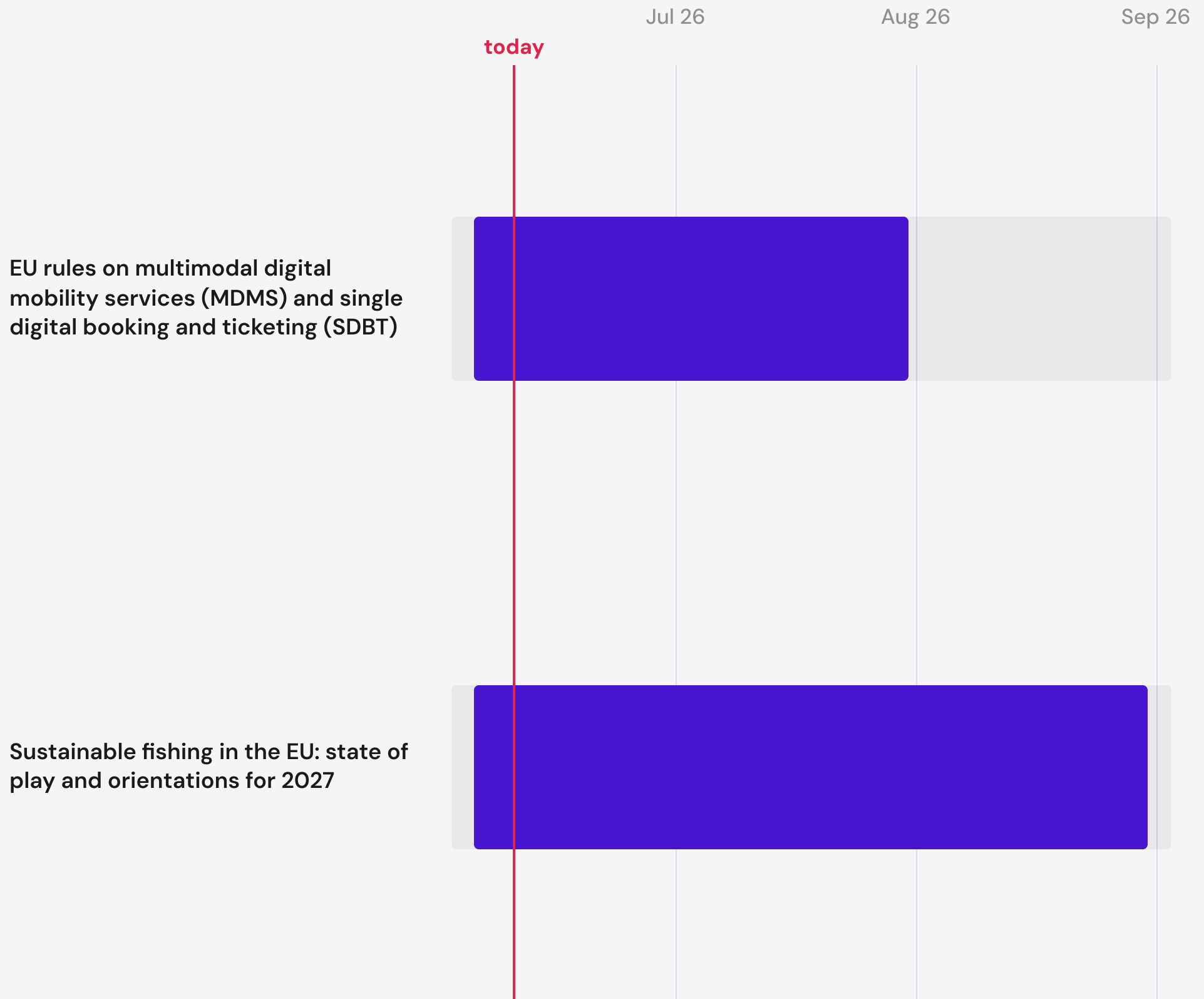

They focus on one hand on improving the online multimodal ticketing market by enhancing transparency, establishing a level playing field for operators and preventing distortion of competition among platforms. On the other hand the Single Digital Booking & Ticketing proposal will focus on rail, aiming at fostering the number of rail tickets and associated fares available on online platforms.

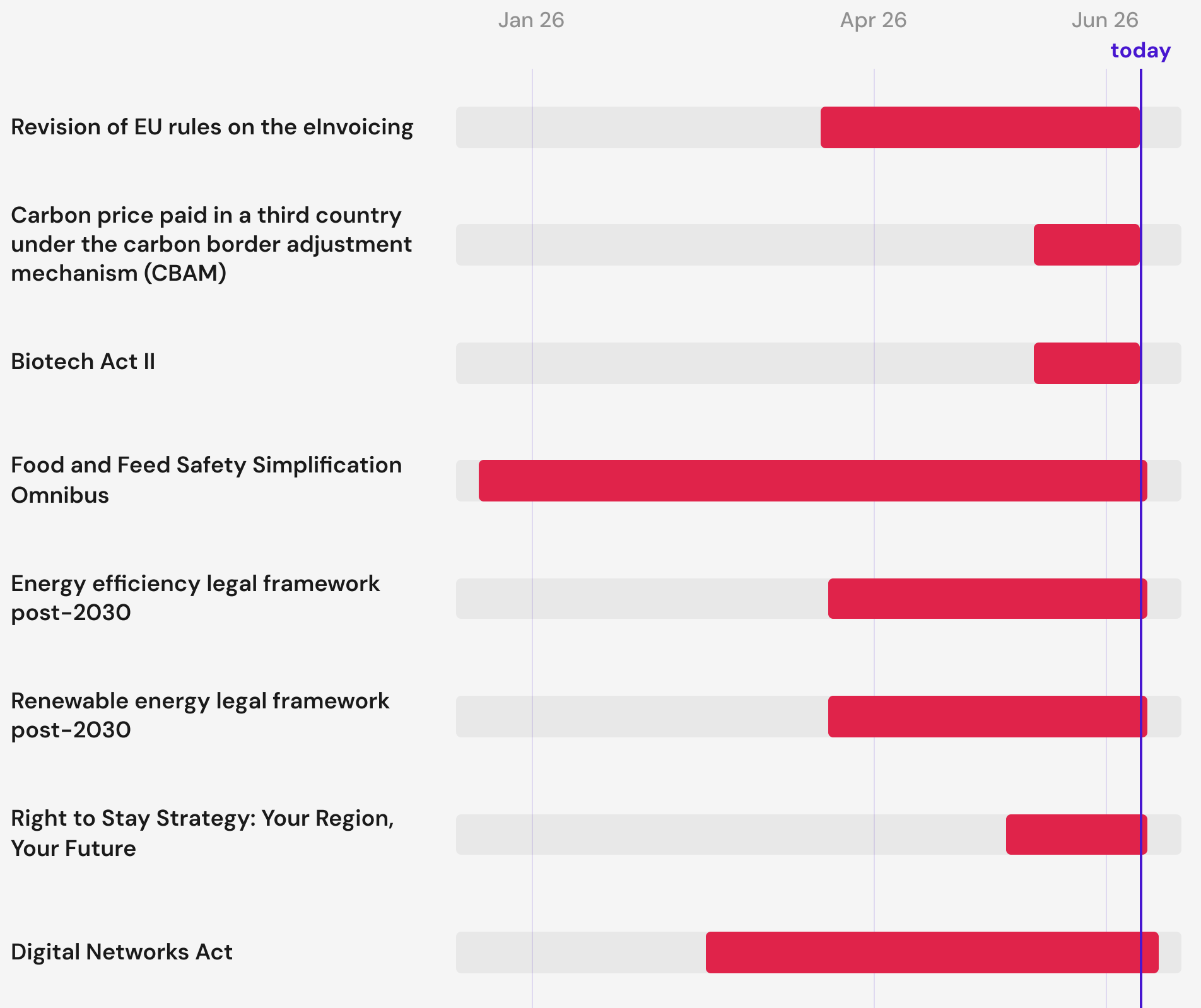

Carbon price paid in a third country under the carbon border adjustment mechanism (CBAM)

This initiative will set out rules for the conversion into a corresponding number of CBAM (carbon border adjustment mechanism) certificates of the carbon price effectively paid in a third country for the declared embedded emissions, taking into account any form of compensation available in that country resulting in a reduction of the price.

The proposed initiative reaffirms biotechnology as a strategic technology across multiple sectors, essential for Europe's competitiveness, resilience, and clean and digital transitions. It ensures a level playing field in the Single Market, eliminating fragmentation and guaranteeing that innovative biotech products and processes can quickly enter and freely circulate within the EU.

Food and Feed Safety Simplification Omnibus

OPEN

 18 Dec 2025  Deadline 12 Jun 2026  Directive

This proposal aims to increase competitiveness of EU farmers and the food and feed industry and to reduce administrative burden to Member States authorities related to marketing authorisations of products. It intends to accelerate the access to the EU market for biocontrol substances and products. The proposal will include simplification and clarification of regulatory requirements on plant protection products, biocidal products, feed additives, food hygiene and official controls, as well as other measures to simplify EU Food Law.

The initiative aims to ensure that energy efficiency contributes to the achievement of the EU climate target of 90% greenhouse gas emissions by 2040 in a cost-efficient way and to strengthen the EU's competitiveness by securing affordable and clean energy for European citizens and industry. The existing legislation is targeted to the 2030 decarbonisation scenario, so it would not suffice to achieve this goal; therefore, setting-up an energy efficiency framework for post 2030 legal framework is necessary.
